# What's the Flood and Earthquake Shazards Map?


## **About the Flood Hazards Map**

It's a map for quick evacuation in case of disasters such as flooding caused by heavy rains.

#### Rivers with greater risks


The following rivers are expected to flood based on estimations by the Government and Saitama Prefecture.

- · Tonegawa
- Edogawa
- · Arakawa
- Nakagawa
- Ayasegawa
- Nakagawa, Ayasegawa, Motoarakawa, Ootoshifurutonegawa, and Niigatakawa Shibakawa and Shinshibakawa



### **About the Earthquake Hazards Map**

We are currently creating three maps for the possible major earthquake in North Tokyo Bay: the Building Hazards Map, the Ground Shaking Map and the Liquefaction Risks Map.



#### **Expected risks of earthquakes**

If a big earthquake hits North Tokyo Bay, Yashio City is expected to feel a seismic scale (shindo) of 6+ and receive the following damage.

- Affected buildings 4,189
  (complete or partial destruction)
- · Affected people 584
- · Evacuees 4.545
