

● Please be sure to sort out garbage and recyclable waste properly and place them by 8:00 am on designated collection day.

(Please don't get closer to a garbage collecting vehicle while it's working because it involves danger.)

Burnable Waste

- Kitchen garbage • Foam polystyrene • Plastic containers • Rubber items • Disposable diapers • Leather items • Soiled paper trash • Vinyl products • Plastic items • Back packs for elementary school children, etc.
- Video tapes • CDs, DVDs • Floppy disks
- Pruned twigs

※ each side should be less than 50 cm in length.

※ cut into small pieces

※ empty

※ remove excrement

※ drain well

※ less than 10 cm in diameter and less than 50 cm in length

[How to place]

Put waste in a transparent or semitransparent bag.

- ※ Don't put waste in cardboard boxes or paper bags.
- ※ Place paper resources (wrapping paper, mixed paper such as paper boxes for tissue paper or confectionery, or cardboard boxes etc.) on designated collection day for recyclable items or for group resource collection in the area.

Unburnable Waste

- **Metal items:** large metal container (for powdered milk, confectionery, seaweeds, and 18-liter Itto-kan for liquid), umbrellas, pots and pans, knives, etc.
- **Small Electrical appliances:** toaster, microwave oven, printer, video player, vacuum cleaner, rice cooker, camera, clock, gas stove, heater, fan heater, etc.
- **Glasses and ceramics**
- **Burnable waste of which side is between 50 cm and 1 m in length :** plastic garment boxes, etc.
- **Slender items less than 2 m in length :** pair of ski, golf club, laundry pole, etc.

※ each side should be less than 1 m in length and less than 10 kg in weight.

※ TV sets (cathode-ray tube, liquid crystal, plasma), air-conditioner, refrigerator, freezer, washing machine, clothes dryer, personal computer are not collected.

● **Hazardous waste:** dry batteries, fluorescent light bulbs, thermometers (including mercury one), etc.

Don't place syringes for collection, please ask medical facilities how to dump them.

[How to place]

- Put waste in a **transparent bag** so as to be checked from outside.
- Put hazardous waste in a **different bag**.
- ※ Don't put items in a cardboard box or a paper bag.

Recyclable Waste

Bottles and Cans

- Empty cans and bottles (broken fragments are also collectable)
- Spray cans • Gas cylinder for cassette stove
- Aluminum foil
- Bottle caps (metal caps only) etc.

※ Spray cans and gas cylinders should be used up and pierced.

Papers

※ Please cooperate not to place on rainy days.

- Card board boxes and etc. • Mixed paper
- Newspaper • Shredded paper • Magazines
- Books • Milk cartons

※ Bind by items.

※ Put them in a plastic bag.

○ **Unrecyclable paper trash** (go to burnable waste)

- sticky things (duct tapes etc.) • photos
- carbon papers • thermal papers • milk cartons with silver lining • dirty or smelling paper trash

Fabric and clothes

※ Please cooperate not to place on rainy days.

Put waste in a transparent or semitransparent bag.

- Towels • Sheets • Blankets • Curtains
- Jackets • Skirts • Pants • Sweaters etc.

○ **Unrecyclable clothes** (treated as burnable waste)

- dirty items • soaked items
- insanitary items • staffed toys
- items used for pets
- pillows • small futon or Japanese mattress(staffed with cotton)
- quilts (staffed with cotton)
- mats • cushions etc.

PET Bottles

Items with PET mark

- Take off cap
- Rip off label
- Rinse off
- Crash

※ Caps and labels are burnable waste

※ Put waste in a transparent or semitransparent bag (Don't make the bag double layers)

[Non-recyclable pet bottles] (treated as burnable waste)

Bottles of

- Cooking oil • Liquid detergent • Shampoo
- Conditioner • Cosmetics • Medical items

Items staffed with tobacco batts • Items filled with medicine • Items colored by handicraft work or such things • Items with sticky tape on or such things • Pet bottles without PET mark

White plastic trays etc

Collection boxes are available to collect items below at city hall, municipal office and etc. Please feel free to use them.

- White trays • Dry batteries • Milk cartons
- Ink cartridges
