Every citizen's involvement is the most important thing in the event of a disaster

It's essential to secure your safety in emergency situations. You can prepare yourself for the possibility of disasters by taking safety measures in your home and being aware of what to do in the event of a disaster.

Instead of relying on the preventive measures introduced in the Hazards Map, it's also important to recognize other potential risks and discuss evacuation plans with others.



Disaster Prevention in Your Neighborhood



A serious disaster such as a major earthquake might delay disaster response to a great extent. It's important to cooperate with neighbors and help each other in order to protect your own community from natural disasters.

The Voluntary Disaster Response Organization (Jishu Bosai Soshiki) was established so that people living in the same vicinity can work together to alleviate the damage caused by disasters. Everyone is welcome to join the organization to participate in disaster response drills and exercises.

- ① Organization of disaster drills and other community-building activities
- ② Lectures on emergency and disaster management skills
- ③ Gathering necessary supplies and materials for disaster response
- ④ Getting to know the neighborhood


2 Activities during a Disaster

- ② Confirming the safety of people with special needs and others
- ③ Initial fire extinguishing, rescuing, providing first-aid
- ④ Administration of evacuation shelters
